regardless of age



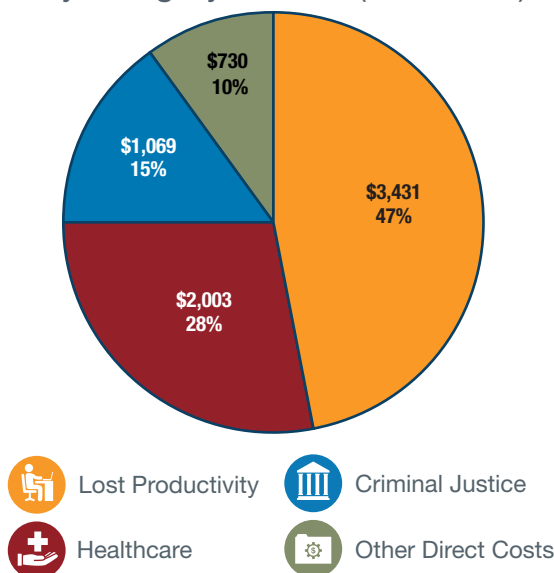

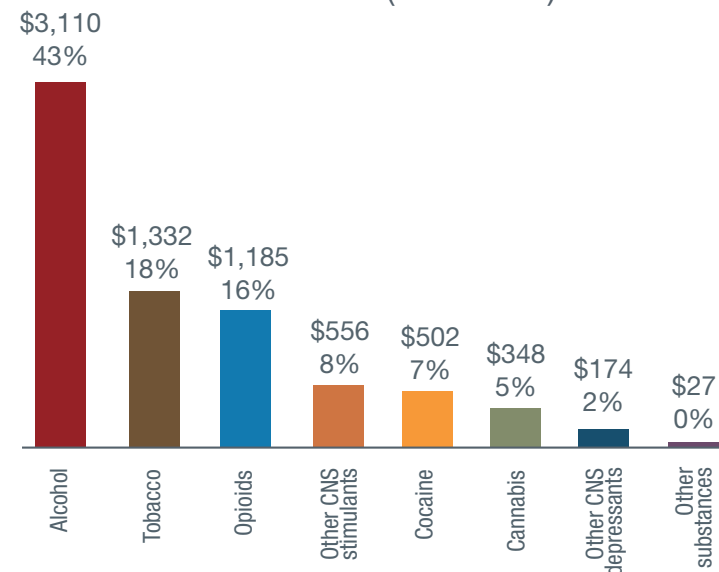
