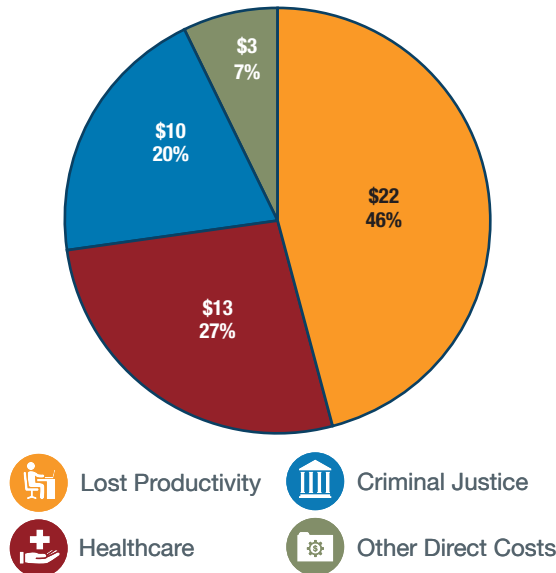
In 2020, substance use cost Canada more than

\$49 BILLION

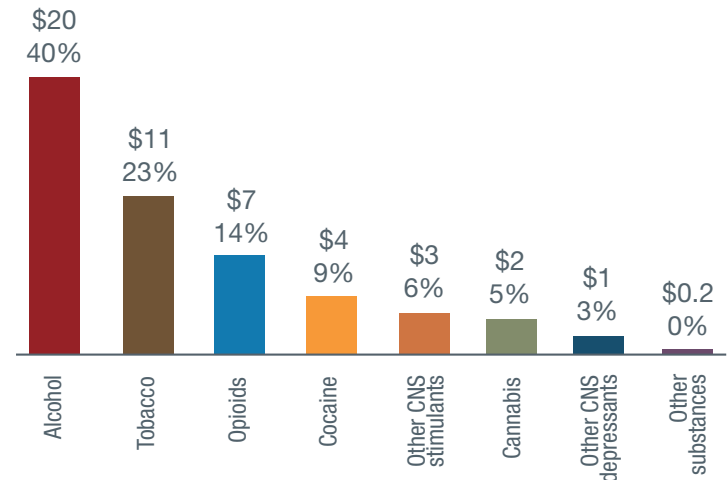
which amounts to **\$1,291 per person** regardless of age



Overall cost attributable to substance use (in billions)

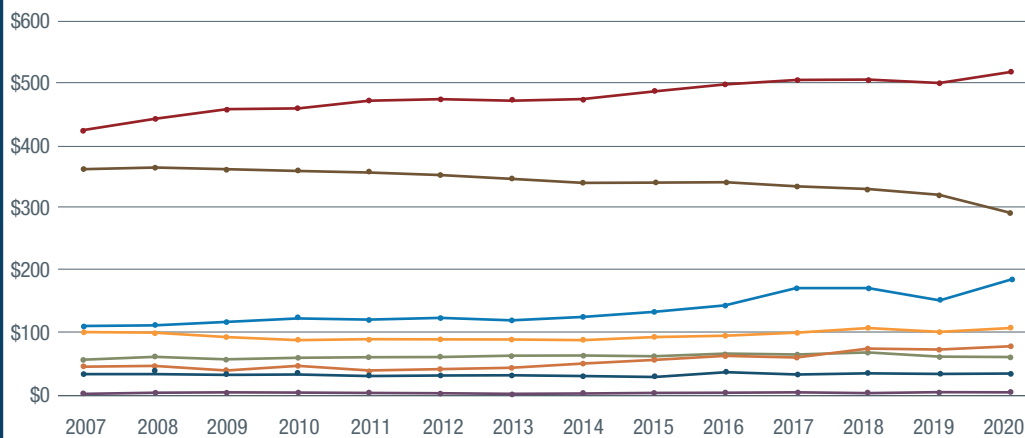


Overall cost of substance use (in billions)
