In 2020, substance use cost Saskatchewan more than

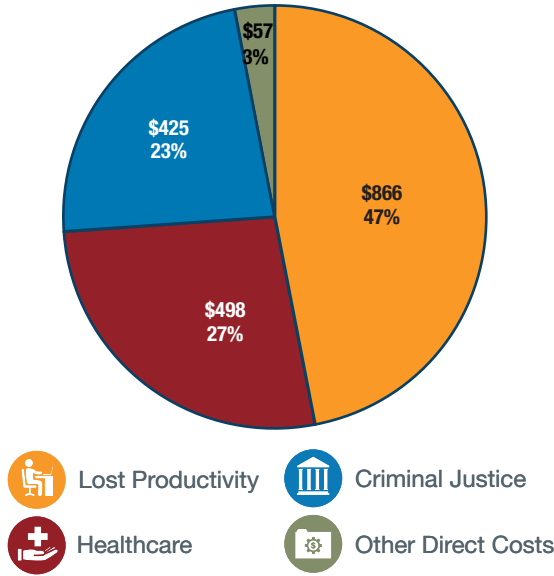
\$1.8 BILLION

which amounts to **\$1,567 per person** regardless of age

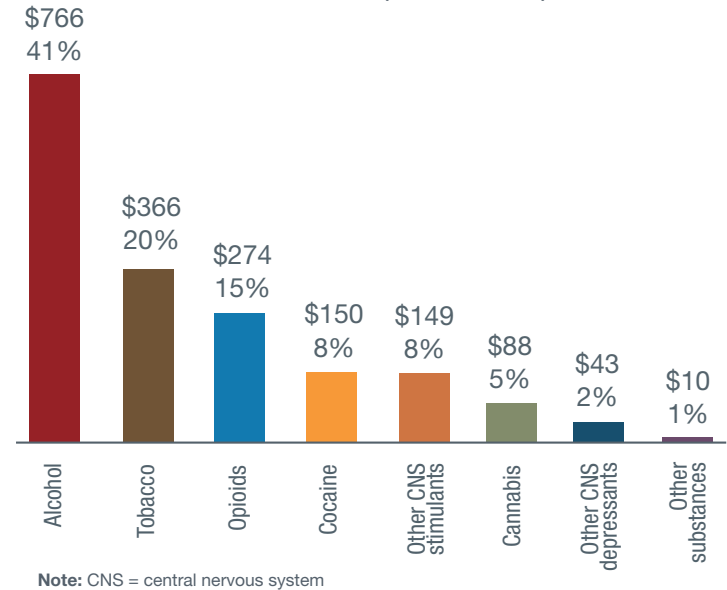

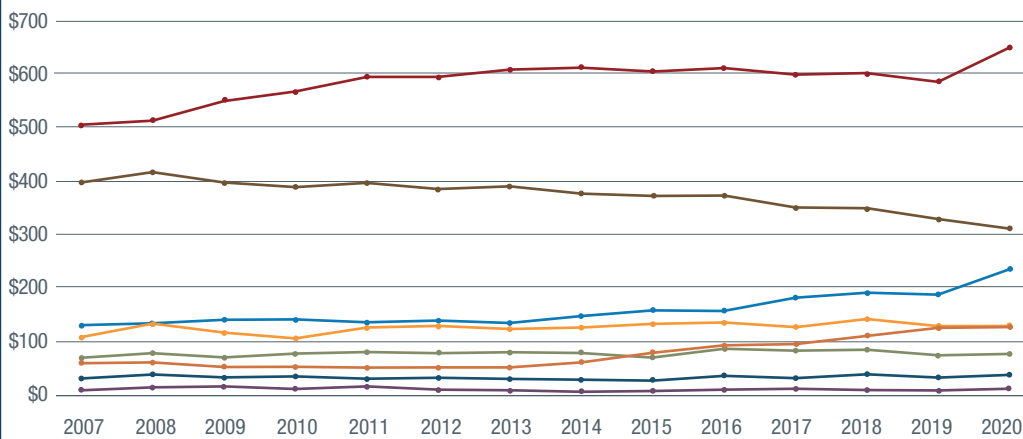
Overall cost of substance use by category in 2020 (in millions)
