In 2020, substance use cost Newfoundland and Labrador more than

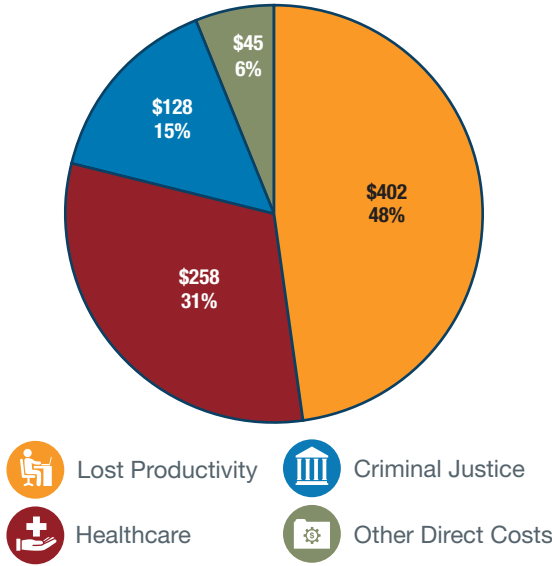

which amounts to **\$1,575 per person** regardless of age

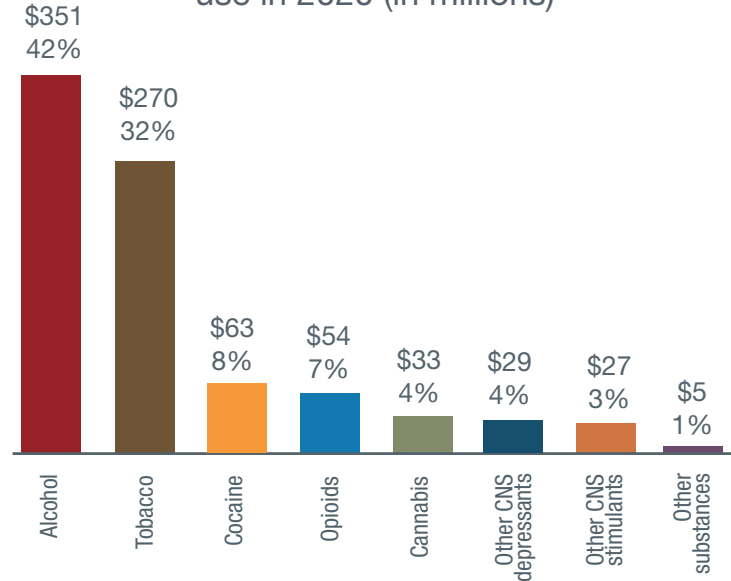


Compared with \$49.1 billion or \$1,291 per person in Canada

Overall cost of substance use by category in 2020 (in millions)

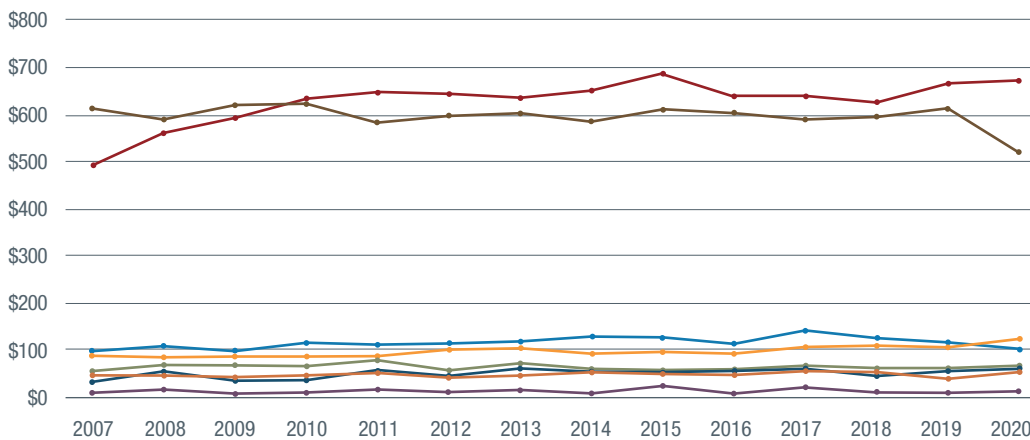


Overall cost of substance use in 2020 (in millions)
