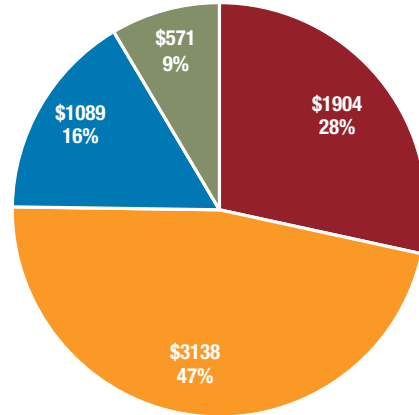
which amounts to \$1,579 per person regardless of age



Compared to almost \$46 billion or \$1,258 per person in Canada

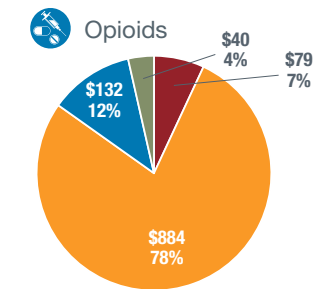
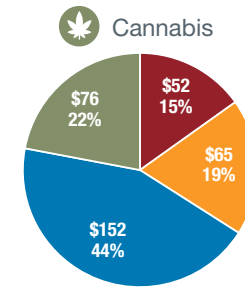
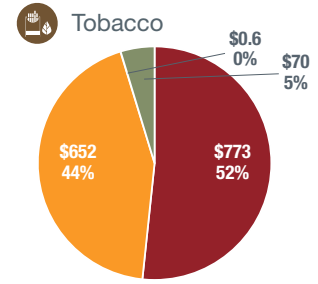
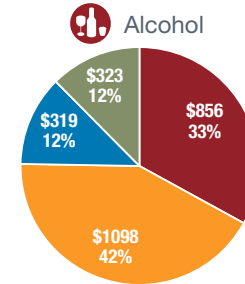
Cost of substance use by category in 2017 (in millions)

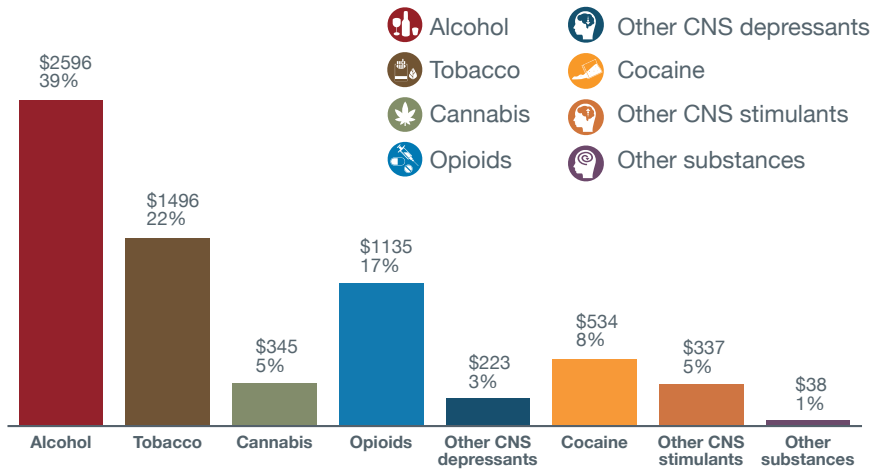
